Brant currently serves as Vice President, Americas Products West Downstream. He is accountable for the profit and loss of Chevron's four refineries and associated fuels trading, logistics, marketing and sales activities in the Western Americas along with driving enterprise value capture across the 'crude to customer' supply chain. He currently serves as Chairman of the Board of California Business Round Table, and is on the Board of Directors for the California Chamber of Commerce, Western States Petroleum Association and the Southern California Leadership Council.

Prior to this Brant served as Vice President, Joint Ventures & Affiliates (JV&A). In this role he oversaw Chevron's JV&A investments globally. Brant has served as a lead Director on the Board of Directors for several large JV&A's such as - GS Caltex in Korea (one of the world's largest Downstream joint ventures); Caltex Australia Limited (a listed ASX 50 company); Chevron India Holdings; Singapore Refinery Company as Deputy Chairman of the Board; and Star Petroleum Refining Company in Thailand as Chairman of the Board (a SET 50 listed company). He also oversaw Chevron's JV manufacturing interests in South Africa, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Pakistan, Kenya, Cameroon, and the Ivory Coast.

Previously, Brant served as the leader for Chevron's Downstream business in Asia Pacific with accountability for the P&L from a crude oil purchase through to refined product revenue. Prior to this he served as General Manager for Asia Pacific - Supply, Trading & Value Chain Optimization.

Brant joined Chevron in 1986 and over the years has held various Refining, Marketing, Supply Chain, Commodities Trading, Strategy Development, Government Affairs and Corporate leadership roles as well as positions of increasing responsibility in Hawaii, North America and Asia.
